## PRE- SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS

Your pet has been scheduled for a surgery or a procedure requiring anesthesia. Following are the instructions you need to follow:

NO FOOD AFTER 8:00 PM THE EVENING BEFORE SURGERY. (SORRY, NO TREATS EITHER). Fresh water should be made available to your pet up until surgery.

Surgery patients are admitted to the hospital between 8-8:30 AM the day of surgery. Surgeries are performed during the morning/early afternoon hours. Please call after 3:00 PM for progress reports and estimated discharge time. Discharges for route surgeries should be picked up before 7:00 PM unless other arrangements have been made.

## YOUR SURGERY INCLUDES

- Pre-op Blood work- A full physical exam was performed on your pet during your initial visit; however our greatest concern is the well-being of your pet. A technician will be monitoring your pet's vital signs and this along with pre-anesthetic blood screening reduces many risks of surgery.
- <u>Post-Operative Pain Management</u>- Thanks to advances in veterinary mælicine, there are approved methods to help alleviate signs of pain and make our pets more comfortable following surgery.

## The following is available at an additional fee

Microchip- a permanent form of identification for your pet. Implanting can be done while your pet is under anesthesia. The cost is \$65.00 including the registration fee to Home Again.

If your pet is having a growth/lump removed, please mark it with nail polish prior to coming in for surgery.
